ARTICLE XIX: LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

1900 Conflict with other Laws

Whenever the regulations of this Ordinance require a greater width or size of yards, or require a greater percentage of lot to be left unoccupied, or impose other more restrictive standards than are required in or under any other statutes, the requirements of this Ordinance shall govern. Whenever the provisions of any other statutes require more restrictive standards than are required by this Ordinance, the provisions of such statutes shall govern.

1901 Separability

Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof which is not specifically declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

1902 Repeal of conflicting ordinances

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

1903 Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its adoption by the City Council of the City of Georgetown.
