



# VOICE PROGRAM

**The VOICE Program is designed to make regular telephone contact with City and County residents that are homebound or infirmed. The purpose of the telephone contact is to perform a welfare check and brighten the resident's day. Currently, volunteers are making calls to residents on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. If contact with the resident is not made on two consecutive shifts, then an officer/deputy will be dispatched to make a welfare check on the resident.**
