TEMPORARY WATER HYDRANT USAGE FEES

Residential (3-Day Term):

Requires a non-refundable payment of \$ 75.00 upon request for service, which covers any usage up to 20,000 gallons during the initial three-day period. A fee of \$5.00 per day will apply for each additional day of use beyond the initial three-day allowance. Payment for any other water consumption in excess of the 20,000 gallon allowance will be calculated using standard water rates then in effect.

Commercial (1-Month Term):

Required an initial security deposit in the amount of \$500.00, \$150.00 of which is non-refundable. This covered usage up to 20,000 gallons during the initial one-month period. A fee of \$25.00 per month will apply for each additional month or part of a month of use beyond the initial one-month allowance. Payment for any water consumption in excess of the 20,000 gallon allowance will be calculated using standard water rates then in effect.

The hydrant meter deposit, less balance due for service, will be refundable with a maximum of six weeks from the time service is terminated. If the balance due is greater than the deposit, the customer will be billed for the difference.
