## LIMITATIONS AND WASTEWATER DISCHARGES

1. Waste haulers must have a valid discharge permit to discharge wastewater into the City's treatment system. This permit is not transferable. If the business is sold or otherwise changes ownership, the new owner must apply for a new permit and business license.
2. A discharge report must be completed before any discharge is made into the system. This report will be completed at the City of Georgetown Wastewater Plant. Also, a grab sample must be taken from all discharges. This sample will be collected at the point of discharge.
3. Domestic wastewater from within the Georgetown service area will be accepted at the Georgetown Plant at 126 Ridge Street. Industrial or commercial wastewater, also from the Georgetown service area, will be accepted only at the lagoon site on Ridge Street. When discharging at the lagoon site, the driver must have in his possession a copy of the discharge report.
4. No industrial or commercial wastewater from any source will be accepted without a prior permit. A permit will be granted only after a sample has been submitted and analyzed and it is determined that the discharge will not pose a problem to the treatment facility. In no case will a discharge be accepted from an industry or commercial establishment that is located outside the normal Georgetown service area without explicit approval by Council.
5. This permit is subject to be modified, suspended, or revoked in whole or in part during its term for causes including, but not limited to the following:
  - a. Discharging in manholes other than the one located at the Georgetown Wastewater Plant or the designated discharge point at the lagoon.
  - b. Violation of any terms or conditions of the permit or other applicable law or regulation.
  - c. Obtaining a permit by misrepresentation or failure to disclose all relevant facts.
6. The Permittee must apply in writing for a renewal permit not less than ninety (90) days prior to expiration of the current permit.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

WASTE HAULER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collect Sample
- Wash down area when discharge is completed
- Remove and replace manhole lids

CITY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Fill out discharge report
- Supervise discharge
- Identify, preserve and refrigerate sample
- Accompany hauler to lagoon to discharge any industrial or commercial waste.
