

**Boil Water Advisory
To Customers of the City of Georgetown
Water Utilities Department**



The City of Georgetown advises the residents of their water system to vigorously boil their water for one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking.

A major line break in the distribution system has resulted in a loss of pressure and service to many customers of the City of Georgetown. This break may have affected the entire water system of the City of Georgetown. There has been no confirmed contamination of the system. However, because of loss of pressure, the potential for contamination exists. Therefore, as a precautionary measure, the residents of the water system are advised to vigorously boil their water for one (1) full minute prior to drinking or cooking until notified otherwise by the City of Georgetown. Also, any ice made from water that has not been boiled should not be used for drinking or cooking.

Employees of the City of Georgetown are working to correct the problem as soon as possible.
