The City of Georgetown will host a public forum to discuss the revised flood maps, flood hazard information, ordinance adoption, and other frequently asked questions and concerns about the newly released Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for Georgetown County. This forum will take place on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 from 4pm-7pm in the City of Georgetown Council Chambers at City Hall, 120 N. Fraser St, Georgetown, SC 29440.

Another public meeting, hosted by Pawley's Island, will be held the following evening on Wednesday, March 9, 2016 from 4pm - 7pm at the Waccamaw Neck Library, 41 St. Paul Place, Pawley's Island, SC 29585. The public is encouraged to attend and ask questions about the new FIRMs and FIS, and how it may affect your flood insurance. There will be flood management experts from local government, state government, and private contractors, who helped create the new preliminary FIRMs.
