

HISTORIC DISTRICT MANHOLE REHABILITATION

The **HISTORIC DISTRICT MANHOLE REHABILITATION** project addresses the condition of 200 of the oldest wastewater manholes in the City. The poor condition of these manholes allows ground wastewater and rain water to Inflow and Infiltrate into the wastewater system. This I/I leads to capacity problems in the pipe network, forcing the City to treat extra water at the Wastewater Plant. After completion we should see a reduction in wet weather flows and a reduction in the clear water treated at the plant.


