(Georgetown) -- Construction on the City of Georgetown's Highway 17 Drainage project continues to effect traffic. Additional street closings were announced today.

Beginning Monday, February 14, 2011, Front Street will be closed to all traffic from Fraser Street to Dozier Street. Side street parking on Cleland Street will be discontinued during the Front Street Closure to aid with traffic between Front and Highmarket Streets. Residents and motorists are urged not to park on Cleland Street during the closing of this portion of Front Street.

The Front street closing is necessary for SC Pipeline to relocate their natural gas distribution main in preparation for the installation of storm water piping for the Highway 17 drainage project. SC Pipeline is the pipeline distributor of natural gas for SCE&G.

Other streets that are currently closed to traffic are Dozier Street from Front to Prince Streets and the foot of Wood Street from Leonard and Sons Shrimp Company to the Sampit River.

Additional street closings will be necessary in the coming weeks as the drainage project continues. They will include closings on Front Street and North Fraser Street. Significant traffic pattern changes will be necessary when portions of Fraser Street are closed. Motorists and Residents should stay tuned to local media for updates on street closings and traffic changes.
