### **City of Georgetown Local Information Statement US Highway 17 Drainage Project**

**Issued April 7, 2011**

#### **For Immediate Release**

(Georgetown) -- Construction on the City of Georgetown's Highway 17 Drainage project continues to effect traffic. Beginning Monday April 11<sup>th</sup>, Front Street will be closed to all traffic from Fraser Street through the Wood Street intersection. Motorists and Residents are encouraged to use Prince or Highmarket Street to King Street to access Front Street.

The Front street closing is necessary for the installation of storm water piping for the Highway 17 drainage project. The closing is expected to last into July.

Other streets that are currently closed to traffic are Dozier Street from Front to Prince Streets and the foot of Wood Street from Leonard and Sons Shrimp Company to the Sampit River.

Additional street closings will be necessary in the coming months as the drainage project continues. They will include closings on North Fraser Street. Significant traffic pattern changes will be necessary when portions of Fraser Street are closed. Motorists and Residents should stay tuned to local media for updates on street closings and traffic changes.
